



dvertised as downtown Raleigh's hidden gem, there could not be a truer statement. The gem part for sure! Nestled in the Hudson building on Wilmington street (across the street from The Edison Lofts), the small Manhattan Cafe is making a BIG name for itself with the downtown Raleigh crowd. It is becoming a usual expectation to see a line out the door during the noon hour of hungry lunch patrons looking to get their MC fix. But, don't let the lines scare you off. The team at the Cafe is well aware of the time people are allotted for lunch and make quick work of getting you in and out. "Everything we do here depends on our ability to handle volume without the quality of our product or service suffering", says Casey Vorbeck, one of the three brothers who own and operate the cafe.

The success that Manhattan Cafe is seeing has not always been the status quo for that location. The Cafe has been operating in downtown since 2008. The Vorbeck brothers bought it from a



previous owner in 2014 and haven't looked back since. "We saw a great location in a growing downtown community that had all the tools to be successful, but wasn't reaching its potential", Casey said. When the brothers took over MC they were doing 80 transactions a day which they have blossomed into over 400 transactions and another 100 plus in off-site catering daily. "The main goal was



to actually be a part of the community, providing a place where people can come and take their mind off work for 30 minutes at a time," oldest brother Nate stated. Your mind will wander there for sure, with graffiti and murals wall to wall, good music and great people watching!

THE MENU

The menu is consistent with a traditional New York Deli with more to offer. Ask them what is their most popular sandwich, they say which one? The Prosciutto de Parma is a big hit with loads of thin sliced Prosciutto, fresh mozzarella and basil. Fresh made deli sandwiches like the Smoked Turkey and French Brie and the Roast Beef and Cheddar are packed with meat! Their top selling hot sandwich is the Cajun Chicken Panini. How can it not be with the slogan of 'Don't be a weenie, try the Cajun chicken panini'. Philly Friday is a tradition with a lot of downtown offices. That's where they offer their Philly Cheesteak w/ fries for 6.99. Along with the deli and grill selections they offer a made to order Pasta Bar and salad bar.

"Our menu is diverse enough to where the entire office can find something they are craving." The brothers noted surprisingly that daily almost half the customers go the healthy route and take advantage of the LARGE made for you salad bar.

CATERING

The catering side of the operation is the next avenue the brothers are expanding. "We are finding a big demand for our catering services through the Triangle", Casey explained. Corporate catering is their go to. Breakfast and lunch to the offices and business in the area. "When you think of business lunch catering more than one national chain comes to mind. Being family owned we have the ability to adapt and change to the customers' current and future needs. It's always nice to be able to talk to someone that has an invested interest in their well-being." You can currently find their catering menu and order through their website. •







WHAT IS THE MEANING OF BLUE LOTUS?

In Eastern traditions, the blue lotus signifies wisdom and the victory of the spirit over the senses. In Alfred Lord Tennyson's poem, Song of the Lotos-Eaters, the blue lotus symbolizes that which urges us to seek new experiences.

Because the lotus grows from mud and finds its way through purifying water to open to the sunlight, the flower also is seen as a metaphor for the path of the individual toward enlightenment, ultimately representing the highest aspiration — seeking enlightenment for the sake of others.



GREEN SPACE

One of the central ethical teachings of yoga is ahimsa, practicing non-violence — doing the least amount of harm. At blue lotus, it also means treading lightly on the Earth. That's why it was so important to us to create a "green" yoga studio. We felt it was an organic part of the practice, and we jumped at the opportunity to lead by example the much-needed paradigm shift toward environmental sensitivity.

When we opened our doors in February 2007, blue lotus was not only the first yoga studio in downtown Raleigh, but it also was the area's first green yoga studio, as recognized by the California-based Green Yoga Association. The association fosters ecological consciousness, reverence and action in the yoga community, and recognizes studios that minimize their environmental impact.

As a member of the association's Program Pilot, we contribute to their Green Studios Handbook to guide other yoga studios to implement green business practices and increase environmental awareness in their students and communities.





hile seated and listening to music from the 1920's through the 1960's, Lisa leads her class through a series of fun and functional movements and stretches designed to increase flexibility, strength, balance and coordination. The class consists of a warm up/stretch routine, then faster and more intense moves to activate all major muscle groups, then a cool down and stretch routine. The music is an integral part of the program. It is entertaining and nostalgic, and provides a fun backdrop for the creation and execution of the movements which are all performed to the music's rhythm.

Chair Move2Music class can be taught at any level, from those with physical and mental limitations to those requiring a more rigorous workout. Lisa gives attention to each individual, allowing her to teach to a multilevel class of low to high functioning students. Her goal is that her energy and encouragement will motivate and inspire her students to become as physically and socially active as possible.

WHO IS LISA LOFCHIE?

Lisa Lofchie is originally from the Boston area, and lived in Arizona and Florida before moving to Raleigh, NC in June 1999. She has been working with senior adults as a companion/caregiver for both an agency and as an independent contractor since her move to Raleigh.

Lisa has been intently practicing aligmentbased yoga for over 30 years and since moving to Raleigh has also been involved in cardio and muscle toning classes.



Through her own fitness practice she realized that she was more motivated to exercise while listening to music she enjoyed. This inspired her, in March of 2012, to create Chair Move2Music for senior adults. Lisa has her Senior Fitness and Yoga Fitness certifications through Interactive Fitness Trainers of America and her CPR certification from the American Heart Association.

WHERE CAN I FIND CLASSES?
